1978: A YEAR TO REMEMBER - DENISE MARSA HAS HER FIRST HIT ON THE UK CHARTS WITH DEAN FRIEDMAN'S LUCKY STARS

**In Honor of the 40th Anniversary of the Release of *Lucky Stars* Marsa Will Premier
Her One-Woman Show **THE PASS** in London**

New York, New York (Thursday, May 10, 2018) - For those who remember Denise Marsa, best known in the UK as “the sexy mystery voice” on Dean Friedman’s *Lucky Stars*, her show **THE PASS** will serve as an opportunity to finally experience in person what a one hit wonder looks and sounds like. **THE PASS** will have a limited run, Thursday thru Saturday, September 20, 21, 22 and 27, 28, 29 at **The Playground Theatre**, 343-453 Latimer Rd, London.

Hardly dormant since 1978, Marsa has written **THE PASS**, aptly subtitled *When Giving Up Is Not An Option, A Story of Artistic Survival*. This show, which includes personal vignettes and original music, captures the decades Marsa has devoted to her work as a songwriter. She has enjoyed various successes including recording the lead voice for The Flirt’s **HELPLESS (You Took My Love)** which was a Top Ten hit on the International Billboard Charts (1984). Marsa has been co-published by Warner Bros. UK, Warner/Chappell Los Angeles, and has won several awards including a platinum record for *Lucky Stars* (CBS, LIFESONG, GTO Records), and the 2013 New Mexico Music Award for Best Adult Contemporary Recording and Song for **Steady** from her album LIVE FOREVER. She also runs and operates KeyMedia Public Relations and Denise Marsa Productions, based out of New York City. In the spring of 2016, Marsa Music entered into an administrative publishing deal with BMG, which has just been extended for another two years. BMG (Gold Songs) is looking after her song catalog; they are also a sponsor and stakeholder in **THE PASS**.

THE PASS is a unique combination of song and story. Audiences will enjoy the poignant lyrics and melodious music combined with the candid anecdotes about her adventurous life; as an artist, musician, lover, publicist, entrepreneur, and mentor spanning from the 1970s through 2018. Anyone struggling with personal issues will relate to Marsa’s entertainingly heartwarming take on career and relationship challenges. It’s a show which combines nostalgic appeal with contemporary relevance, as well as songs which will linger in your head for days.
